She handled proceedings on electric and natural gas rate and fuel cases for each of Wisconsin's five major investor-owned utilities; construction cases involving new high-voltage transmission lines, fossil fuel-fired power plants and renewable generation projects; environmental retrofit cases; and generic policy investigations.
