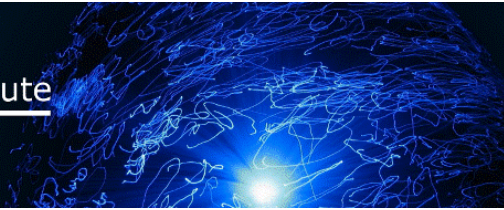

Todd Stuart is executive director of the Wisconsin Industrial Energy Group, Inc. (WIEG). WIEG is a non-profit association of large energy consumers that advocates for policies that drive affordable and reliable energy. WIEG currently represents over 30 Wisconsin businesses that serve as key drivers of economic growth and development throughout the state. WIEG testifies before

the Legislature, the Public Service Commission and the Department of Natural Resources in order to control costs for large ratepayers.

Prior to joining WIEG, Todd held key positions both the Legislative and Executive branches of state government. His work was instrumental in the passage of 2005 Act 141, the Energy Efficiency and Renewables Act and 2003 Act 89, a utility infrastructure streamlining law. Todd was heavily involved in two utility financing laws as well as the 2001 State Energy Policy. Finally, he has served on numerous appointments to state government task forces/work groups related to generation supply, CHP, renewables and energy efficiency.
