Flora Flygt was in the electric utility industry for approximately 35 years in a variety of planning and leadership positions. She has worked for Madison Gas & Electric Company, Alliant Energy, and American Transmission Company LLC (ATC). She was involved in many innovative electric planning approaches including leading the development of integrated resource planning and participating in demand-side planning at Madison Gas & Electric Company. She implemented a leading-edge strategic flexibility approach to investment decisions at

Alliant Energy, where she was Director of Corporate Research and Market Planning. As Director of Transmission Planning at ATC, Flora led the development of the first economically justified transmission project in MISO and of ATC's first Multi-Value Projects approved by MISO in 2011. She has been an expert witness on transmission planning, long-term electric forecasting, demand-side planning, and integrated resource planning. She has presented at and chaired many industry conferences and was very actively involved in the Eastern Interconnection Planning Collaborative. Flora holds an M.S. degree in Land Resources with a Master's certificate in Energy Analysis & Policy from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and a B.A. degree in Economics from the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor.
