Dennis Derricks was named director of regulatory affairs at WEC Energy Group in 2015. In this role, Dennis has responsibility for retail electric rate design, cost of service and fuel cost recovery for We Energies and Wisconsin Public Service.

Dennis joined Wisconsin Public Service in 1991 as a rates engineer. In 1995, he was appointed electric rates supervisor, overseeing the administration,

development and implementation of retail product and service pricing. As supervisor, he implemented many successful electric programs, including customer buyback offerings, critical peak pricing programs and special contracts. Between 2003 and 2013, Dennis served as director of electric regulatory policy and analysis. In 2013, he became assistant vice president of regulatory affairs, responsible for developing and implementing regulatory strategy, as well as making rate case and cost recovery filings for all gas and electric utilities.

Prior to his career at Wisconsin Public Service, Dennis was employed as a distribution engineer for Ohio Edison and as a project engineer for Fort Howard Paper Company. He holds a Bachelor of Science in electrical engineering, with emphasis in electric power systems, from Michigan Technological University and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh.

Dennis currently serves as president of the Statewide Energy Efficiency and Renewables Administration. He is a member of the Electric Retail Quadrant of the North American Energy Standards Board as well as the Michigan Gas and Electric Association.
