Dave has been the director of the Wisconsin DNR's Environmental Analysis and Sustainability program since 2003. His program works closely with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin on the environmental impact review and permitting of all energy and utility projects statewide, including major transmission line, pipeline, and generation facility project cases. A wetland ecologist by training, Dave has worked for DNR for 26 years.

The program is also responsible for

- developing and implementing policy related to state and local transportation projects, including the management of an interagency cooperative agreement with WisDOT
- conducting multi-disciplinary environmental impact assessment and review of complex projects and policies under the Wisconsin Environmental Policy Act (WEPA)
- providing social science research and analysis
- providing outreach and support to small businesses who need help understanding the DNR programs that might affect their operations
- providing support to companies that are committed to going beyond compliance and superior environmental performance
- certifying laboratories that provide data services to the agency
- certifying professional competencies for wastewater operators, drinking water system operators, well drillers, landfill operators and septage haulers.
