Benjamin Gerber is the executive director of Midwest Renewable Energy Tracking System (M-RETS). Prior to joining M-RETS in 2015, Benjamin served as director of energy and labor/management policy at the Minnesota Chamber of Commerce. He joined that organization in January 2012, representing the Chamber's energy interests at both the Legislature and the Public Utilities Commission.
