

RICHARD LOZIER, Jr. lowa Utilities Board

Richard Lozier was appointed to the Iowa Utilities Board on May 1, 2017, for a term that runs through April 30, 2023. Prior to joining the Board, Richard was a member of the Belin McCormick law firm in Des Moines for more than 20 years. During much of that time, a major component of his practice involved regulated utilities, including telecommunications, wind energy development, electric transmission, water, and gas and oil pipelines.

While in private practice, he was president of the Polk County Bar Association and served on the Board of Governors of the Iowa State Bar Association. He was also president of the Rotary Club of Des Moines and the Des Moines YMCA Camp Board of Managers, as well as serving on the Metro YMCA Board of Directors.
