Kevin Vannoy is the director of market design at the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) where he leads the evaluation and design of enhancements to MISO's energy and operating reserves markets, financial transmission rights, and resource adequacy requirements. He has been with MISO since 2005, serving in leadership roles across the company, including in forward operations, market administration, and market services. Prior to joining MISO, Kevin held management roles with Structure Consulting Group LLC, in their regional transmission organization consulting practice, and with Accenture, in their utilities industry practice.
