She is a former state utility regulator with 25 years of experience in energy and environmental regulatory policy. Prior to starting Talberg Policy Solutions LLC in 2021 to consult on clean energy strategies, Sally served as a gubernatorial appointee on the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) from 2013-20, including over four years as chair and as president of the Organization of MISO States in 2016. As a commissioner, Sally served on various state, regional, and national boards and committees on electricity, natural gas, oil, infrastructure, and telecommunications issues. Prior to serving at the MPSC, Sally was a senior consultant at Public Sector Consultants where she co-led the development of Michigan Saves, a nonprofit green bank that has financed over \$300 million in energy efficiency projects. Sally also served in an advisory capacity to commissioners at the Public Utility Commission of Texas and the Michigan Public Service Commission addressing retail and wholesale market issues, facility siting, ratemaking, and other regulatory issues. Sally holds a bachelor of science in environmental and natural resources policy studies from Michigan State University and a master's degree in Public affairs from the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas at Austin.
