Eric Udelhofen is vice president of development with OneEnergy Renewables where he shepherds projects from inception through construction. He manages prospecting and site identification, landowner outreach, permitting and interconnection processes, and customer outreach for utility-scale solar projects across the country. He has worked in renewable energy since joining EDP Renewables (f.k.a. Horizon Wind Energy) in 2007 as a financial analyst.
