Summer Strand was appointed to the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) by Governor Tony Evers in March 2023 for a six-year term, becoming chair in 2024. Currently, Summer is president of the Mid-America Regulatory Conference. She is a member of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners and serves on the advisory council of the New

Mexico State University Center for Public Utilities. She is also a proud member of the Honorary Committee of the National Utilities Diversity Council. Prior to joining the PSCW, Summer was the director of government affairs for the Walbec Group, a Wisconsin-based construction and engineering firm. Previously, Summer oversaw the State of Wisconsin Building Program as administrator of the division of facilities development at the Wisconsin Department of Administration. She also served as an advisor to and citizen member of the State Building Commission. Summer began her career in the Wisconsin State Senate.
